Regional Timing Equipment – RSO still needs to invoice MLRC for timing equipment use at the MLRC Winter Rallycross event & the Markham event.

- b. Competitor Calls Ross Ross & others called competitors before BBR to ask whether they would be coming out to BBR & if not, why not. A number of them said it was too close to BDC date. Majority of them will be coming out to Pines. The number 1 feedback comment from people with regards to BBR was the date look into moving it for 2020 (later in July?) or possible venue change.

- **d. Sponsorship** Discussions with sponsors have been on going. There are 2 sponsors that would like to contribute towards the 2020 OPRC season with the intention that the money goes to competitors in some form or another. On going discussions to decide on how to use the money.

e. RallySprint Championship – First event on Saturday Aug 24th on BBR roads. 15 series entries but 3 cannot attend the first event. A little short on volunteers. MSGear has provided sponsorship for year-end & event prizes.

One competitor is still looking for a co-driver – discussion was brought up with the sprint organizers that there is no specific rule written that drivers in the series must have a co-driver. It is definitely expected by CARS for rallysprint – the CARS Rules Committee will have to look into the loophole.

Still to do: Prepare championship scoring, announce & post start order, check rallysprint licences & recruit a few more volunteers.

f. CARS AGM 2020 – Location confirmed as the Hilton Garden Inn in Ottawa (near airport). ECRC & OPRC awards will be held here – RSQ to confirm. CARS will send out OPRC award recipient invitations – would be nice if can add the OPRC logo to the invitations as well
